

## **Employment Action Plan for Persons with Disabilities**

### **Guiding questions for community feedback**

The Government of New Brunswick is committed to the development of an *Employment Action Plan for Persons with Disabilities* in collaboration with community, employers, and government. The Plan aims to increase labour force participation of persons with disabilities in the province. The Co-chairs of the Steering Committee, MLA Danny Soucy and Employer Representative Jonathan Davenport (UPS Canada), welcome submissions to the consultation process. Submissions should be received by the Premier's Council on the Status of Disabled Persons, no later than **January 20<sup>th</sup>**. Submissions may want to reflect the following guiding questions:

1. What is working well right now in terms of programs, services and policies? What makes it successful?
2. What kinds of supports/programs are needed to assist persons with disabilities in finding and maintaining meaningful employment?
3. What do you think employers need in order to attract, hire, retain, and develop more people with disabilities?
4. What are the top three initiatives or critical changes that need to be made as soon as possible to assist people with disabilities to find and maintain employment?
5. Is there any other insight or information you would like to add?
