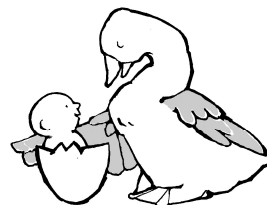


**YOUR GRANDMA AND MY GRANDMA: CONNECTING CULTURES
THROUGH THE PARENT-CHILD MOTHER GOOSE PROGRAM®

The Parent-Child Mother Goose Program is a group experience for parents and their babies and young children focusing on the pleasure and power of using oral and through the air rhymes, songs, and stories together.

This is an exciting new workshop that will develop skills and build repertoire to connect cultures as we use the principles and methods developed by the Parent-Child Mother Goose Program® to benefit parents and babies.

This workshop will focus on:

- Helping parents share rhymes, songs and stories, as well as their experiences with this material
- Working with groups with participants from many cultures or one culture
- Working bilingually and with many languages in a group
- Drawing on and learning to share oral material from your own background as a teacher in the P-CMGP

Participants will receive articles and ideas on the importance of the mother tongue, cultural sensitivity and the importance of storytelling in connecting cultures.

Cost includes a copy of **Bounce Me, Tickle Me, Hug Me; Lap Rhymes and Play Rhymes from Around the World**. Thirty rhymes collected from people who remember them from their own childhoods. Each is in its original language with a lively English adaptation and directions for use. (\$16 value.)
