

Things To Do While You Wait!

- ♠ **Elimination** – Using an old receipt or note, cross out the letters one by one. Start with the “A’s” then move on to “B” and so on.
- ♠ **Talk about Life** – Talk with your child. “When I grow up, I want to be...” or “When I was little, I always wanted to ...”
- ♠ **Take Time** – Use your watch or the wall clock to time things going on around you, teach your child to tell time, or recognize numbers.
- ♠ **Count it** — Count by two’s, three’s, five’s or ten’s. Try counting backwards from 100.
- ♠ **Clap it out** – Teach each other clapping games or rhythms. Make up some new ones
- ♠ Count your **pennies, nickels and dimes.**
