In collaboration with the Stardale Women's Group, the Glenbow Museum presents the Sacred Weft Exhibit.

This tapestry collection was designed by a group of Plains Aboriginal women participating in a revival of Salish weaving techniques. Honouring the rhythms of the seasons, the flowers, berries, plants and roots were gathered at the appropriate time allowing the women to

produce fibres fused with colours indigenous to the region where they grew. Capturing the essence of an ancient art form, the designs and colours resonate harmony, balance and healing, creating symbols of continuity and hope for future generations.
